

## **Terms and Conditions of Participation in the Bildungscampus Ideas Competition, the "Think zero" Challenge**

### **1. Purpose of the Ideas Competition and Organizer**

- 1.1 These Terms and Conditions of Participation govern the terms of participation in the Bildungscampus ideas competition, the "Think zero" challenge ("**Ideas Competition**"). The Ideas Competition is being run as part of the sustainability strategy at the Bildungscampus of Dieter Schwarz Stiftung Heilbronn.
- 1.2 The organizer of the Ideas Competition is Dieter Schwarz Stiftung Heilbronn gGmbH, Bildungscampus 9, 74076 Heilbronn (the "**Organizer**").
- 1.3 At the same time as the Ideas Competition, a special prize is being awarded for sustainable mobility by the LOGWERT competence center of Hochschule Heilbronn. These Terms and Conditions of Participation do not apply to that prize.

### **2. Participation**

- 2.1 Anyone who is 18 years of age or older is eligible to participate in the Ideas Competition. Academic staff of the LOGWERT competence center and the Organizers are precluded from participating. Participation under a false name or under the name of a third party is prohibited.
- 2.2 You may participate as part of a team consisting of at least two people ("**Participating Team**").
- 2.3 In order to participate, you must register by completing the registration form at <https://www.dieter-schwarz-stiftung.de/foerdergebiete/bc-challenge.html#anmeldung>. Once registered, participants will receive the application documents by e-mail.
- 2.4 Entries may be submitted until March 15, 2022 by completing the application documents accurately and in full and sending them to [bc-challenge@dieter-schwarz-stiftung.de](mailto:bc-challenge@dieter-schwarz-stiftung.de). Participants will receive a confirmation e-mail following the receipt of their application.
- 2.5 Participation is free of charge.

### **3. Selection of the winner**

- 3.1 A jury will assess the submitted application documents based on a list of objective criteria. Further information on the selection criteria is available at <https://www.dieter-schwarz-stiftung.de/foerdergebiete/bc-challenge.html#challenge>.
- 3.2 We reserve the right to conduct a round of public voting after the jury has made its assessment, during which the ideas selected by the jury in accordance with clause 3.1 may be viewed online in video form or as a fact sheet for the purpose of a public vote. The jury shall not be bound by the results of the public vote.
- 3.3 The three best ideas will receive a cash prize, which will be provided and transferred by the Organizer (see clause 4.1), and will be announced as the winners.
- 3.4 Winners will be notified by e-mail.

#### **4. Prize money**

4.1 The Organizer will provide the following prize money for the winners:

- 1st prize: EUR 1,500.00
- 2nd prize: EUR 1,000.00
- 3rd prize: EUR 500.00

4.2 The prize money will be paid out only once to each winning participant or Participating Team.

4.3 The prize money will be transferred to the account nominated by each winner following completion of the Ideas Competition.

4.4 In addition to the cash prize, each winner will receive a non-cash prize of a one-year digital subscription to the magazine "Enorm". The non-cash prize will be awarded to each member of a Participating Team.

4.5 Non-cash prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.

#### **5. Disqualification**

5.1 Any breach of these Terms and Conditions of Participation gives us the right to disqualify the relevant participant from further participation. This will particularly be deemed the case if the participant provides false information, or the submitted ideas, photos used or other content infringes third party rights. If a person participates as part of a Participating Team, the whole Participating Team will be disqualified.

5.2 If the disqualified participant has already been judged a winner, they may be subsequently stripped of their win.

#### **6. Early termination and changes**

We reserve the right to terminate, at any time, all or part of the Ideas Competition early, even without complying with any notice period, or to change the running of the competition at any time if it is not possible to properly conduct the Ideas Competition for technical or legal reasons.

7.2 German law shall apply. No recourse may be had to a court of law.
